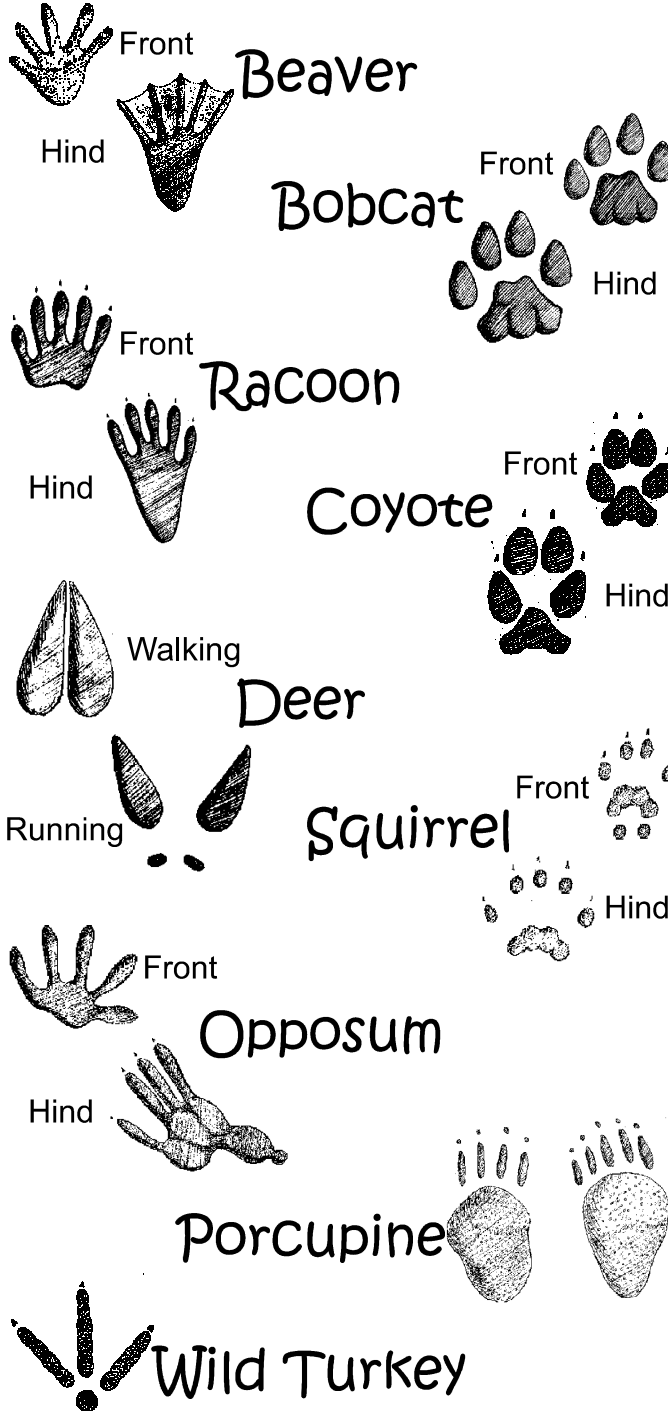


Hiking Safety Tips:

- **Drink plenty of water!** Dehydration is the first step towards heat exhaustion. Drinking soda will only make you more dehydrated.
- **Don't push beyond your limits.** Take your time and enjoy nature at your own pace.
- **Don't hike alone.**
- **Please be aware of Camp Kitaki's boundaries.** Camp is bordered by Highway 66, the Platte River, Platte River State Park, as well as some private land. If you cross a fence, you may be entering private land.
- **Care for the Earth.** Please bring litter back to a proper receptacle.
- **Stay on trails.** Poison ivy grows in many places throughout camp.
- **When walking on camp roads,** please step aside for automobiles.
- **Many camp trails are used by horses.** If you come across a riding group:
Step off the trail and wait.
Announce yourself in a calm voice before the riders are next to you.
Try not to startle the horses.
Once the riders have passed, continue on your hike.
